- Documentation of Payment of Allowable Expenses (for prior year's disbursement)
- Documentation of Financial Need for the coming year--this can simply be a list of anticipated allowable expenses for the next academic year (tuition, room & board, etc.) along with a list of anticipated financial resources (scholarships and grants, not loan or work study amounts).
- Essay: *A Reflection on the Past Year and My Continuing Plans for Education*
- Certification and Signature Form* (signed and dated)
